Mission Sermon Series - 6 weeks

Jesus Sends Out the Twelve - Mark 6:7-13

Then Jesus went around teaching from village to village. **7** Calling the Twelve to him, he began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over impure spirits.

8 These were his instructions: “Take nothing for the journey except a staff—no bread, no bag, no money in your belts. **9** Wear sandals but not an extra shirt. **10** Whenever you enter a house, stay there until you leave that town. **11** And if any place will not welcome you or listen to you, leave that place and shake the dust off your feet as a testimony against them.”

12 They went out and preached that people should repent. **13** They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.

1. **Pattern** - At the very beginning of this passage we see that the Disciples had already spent time with Jesus seeing how he did things. They had learned the pattern of his ministry and could therefore adopt this pattern themselves modelling their own ministry upon his. - Exodus 34:29-35 / Mark 6:7-13
2. **Permission** - Jesus called his disciples and sent them out. We do not go and share our faith because this is a nice idea or even because we've got some exciting news to share. No, we too are called and we too are sent out. - 1 Samuel 3:7-11 / Matthew 10:16-20
3. **Partnership** - The disciples are sent out together in pairs. Mission is not a “lone ranger” style thing but rather something we engage in as a community. The community dimensions of mission are essential for us to grasp and embrace. - Luke 10:1-7 / Acts 16:1-10
4. **Preparation** - Jesus is very clear with his disciples that one on mission is to travel light. There is no need for vast practical preparations as all that is needed will be provided. It is important to consider what is essential by way of preparation and what is not. - Exodus 16:11-18 / Matthew 10:9-15
5. **Purpose** - We need to remain focussed on the essentials of mission. That is, why we are doing what we are doing and the elements of what it is we are there to do. - 1 Cor 9:19 - 27 / Luke 10:8-20
6. **Power** - When we are obedient to our calling and engaging as commanded we will find that we are empowered by the Holy Spirit to engage in the mission to which we have been called. “When the Holy Spirit comes you will receive power.” - 1 Kings 18:30-39 / John 20:19-23
